## Replacing GST won't be a good move, says Eswaran

**PETALING JAYA:** Bringing back the Sales and Services Tax (SST) to replace the Goods and Services Tax (GST) will impact businesses negatively, said Tan Sri Kenneth Eswaran.

better and more effective, in view of SST's weaknesses in the areas of compounding effects, transfer pric-

ing and value shifting.

Last week, Pakatan Harapan chairman Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad proposed that SST replace the GST if the Opposition coalition takes over the Federal Government after the next general election.

He had said that removing GST without replacing it with an alternative source of revenue would be "very bad" for the Pakatan Harapan government.

Eswaran pointed out that the GST

has many benefits.

It is administered in a fully comouterised environment, helping to speed up processes such as refund claims, he said in a statement yeserday.

Also, he said, GST is "levied fairy", in that more people paid tax nstead of just those who were pay-

ng income tax.

"All the benefits provided by the mplementation of GST help stimuate economic growth and boost the nation's competitiveness in the lobal market," he said.

Eswaran described Dr Mahathir's proposal as premature, saying that eplacing the GST would involve a ecision by all the Pakatan parties, ot just Parti Pribumi Bersatu Ialaysia that is helmed by the forMinistry of Finance Malaysia No. 5 Persiaran Perdana Presint 2, Federal Government Administrative Centre, 62592 WP PUTRAJAYA
